Celebrate Social Development Week 2010 with us by joining our very first Photo and Poetry Contest!

The Caucus of Development NGO Networks (CODE-NGO), a coalition of NGO networks committed to social development, invites YOU to be part of the change. Through photos and poetry, share with us your view of what it means to be active in your community and in making it better. Entries should capture Filipino citizens who help transform the lives of others in a community. What we aim to highlight are the voluntary efforts of ordinary people or organized groups to help bring about change and growth for our country. Photographs and poems will be judged mainly by their creativity and originality, composition, artistic merit, and content.

### **Who may join:**

Young amateur photographers and poets 16 to 30 years old.\*

### **How to join:**

1. For photographers, submit the "Registration Form for Photographers" and enclose or attach a maximum of five (5) 8R size photos either by mail or e-mail to designated submission points. Submission period is from October 1 to 30, 2010. (Finalists will be selected from the entries, which will be displayed at the SDW2010 NGO Trade Fair at Trinoma Mall from November 15 to 18, 2010 and will be the subject of the related Poetry Contest).
2. For poets, submit the "Pre-Registration Form for Poets" to designated submission points from October 1 to November 15, 2010. Personally appear on **November 16, 2010, 1:00PM** at the SDW2010 NGO Trade Fair, Activity Center, Trinoma Mall, EDSA corner North Avenue, Quezon City to view the Photo Contest Finalists. Then choose the photo which will most inspire you and write your verses on-the-spot based on the photo and the contest theme.

Get the chance to win P7,000 (1st Prize), P5,000 (2nd Prize) or P3,000 (3rd Prize) for each of the two categories. Winners will be announced at the closing of the SDW2010 NGO Trade Fair in Trinoma Mall on November 18, 2010.

\*Proof of age will be requested prior to any awarding of prize. For more details, download contest guidelines.
