This project aims to help improve the state of local governance through integrating CSOs participation in local government processes and promoting CSOs active engagement in local governance

Objectives:

- Develop a Knowledge Map of CSOs in local governance
- Strengthen capacities of CSOs on how to engage with LGUs and find other venues for participation in local governance through policy discussions and development
- Improve access of CSOs to local governance through policy reforms and strengthening the Local Special Bodies (LSB)
- Promote CSOs and citizens' volunteerism by participating in immersions programs and providing technical assistance
- Develop a performance evaluation and feedback mechanism to help government assess LGU performance
- Strengthen GO-CSO partnerships
