






- ADRN is a regional network of think tanks working on research to support the promotion of democratic consolidation in Asian democracies



On Collaboration between Academe and CSOs

- The Academe and CSOs individually have their own strengths
 - Academe has the expertise in methodology and theoretical content
 - CSOs have the local knowledge (communities of practice and empirical data) and means to take action
- Working together, they can leverage on their own strengths and advance causes better than any single one of them can
- Academe is distinct from CSOs but this is sometimes blurred
- But we absolutely need to work together at this time


